7. All scholarships / bursaries / waivers offered by Taylor’s University are subject to the terms and conditions.
8. The University reserves the right to decide on the number of scholarships to be awarded.
9. Students are entitled to only ONE (1) scholarship / bursary / waiver at any one time, including sponsorship from other institutions/bodies. The one with the highest quantum will automatically apply. However, students are still entitled to the alumni family discount.

10. This Scholarship offered is valid for the duration of the programme offered and strictly cannot be transferred to any other programmes at Taylor's University.
11. In the event the student withdraws from the programme before completion, this Scholarship will be discontinued immediately.
12. Scholarship and study grant recipients are required to meet a minimum CGPA 3.00 at the end of each academic year in order to enjoy the scholarship / study grant in the subsequent year. Failure to meet such academic requirement will have the scholarship / study grant terminated.
